

## **NASHVILLE METHODIST CHURCH KIDSPACE SUMMER CAMP**



Thank you for choosing NMC KIDSPACE SUMMER CAMP for your child this summer! This year will be full of exciting activities including Bible lessons, music, games, field trips and more! Our summer camp is geared for students ages 5 - 10. Our hours are 7:15am - 6:00pm Monday - Friday. The Director, Mrs. Kimberly House will be the lead staff member at camp this year. If you have any questions, please contact her at 252-459-7636. Summer Camp Registration will open on Tuesday, March 4th. Members of the church will be considered first. Registration is \$75.00. The weekly rate is \$150.00. Cost will include 2 field trips. Campers will need to bring their lunch and a morning and afternoon snack EACH day.

In order to provide adequate staffing, you will need to sign up for the weeks that your camper **WILL ATTEND**. You will be **RESPONSIBLE** for **PAYMENT** for the weeks that you **SIGN UP TO ATTEND**. Payment for weekly camps are to be paid **IN ADVANCE**. Please pay at the **BEGINNING** of the week that **CAMP** starts. KIDSPACE will be using **BRIGHTWHEEL** for a payment option. **ALL STUDENTS WILL HAVE A BRIGHTWHEEL ACCOUNT**. You can choose to pay with cash or check, but it must be paid **BEFORE** the start of the week the student attends camp.

Campers must be self sufficient in the restroom, be completely toilet trained and be able to change their clothes for any water activities.

Field trips will be announced via notes home or the FACEBOOK Kidspace page the week before. Some field trips may require an extra fee due to a larger cost than budgeted for. Please be aware that we will try not to do this, but to offer quality experiences, this may occur. ALL campers are EXPECTED to listen and follow directions at camp in order to be able to attend field trips.

IF at any point a camper becomes disruptive to the group, the parent will be notified. If we have more than 3 incidents, we have the right to dismiss the camper from the program after a conference with the parent.

If your camper has fever, excessive cough, mucus of color, diarrhea, vomiting, a rash or other illness they should NOT come to camp. They must be symptom free for 24 hours without medication to come back to camp.

Lice can be a problem at camp. We ask that if your camper has long hair, that it is put up in a high ponytail. There is also a spray on the market to deter lice.

I am looking forward to an exciting summer! We can have a WONDERFUL time if we all work together to follow these rules for a great time of SUMMER FUN in KIDSPACE SUMMER CAMP!
